Our initiatives include


Instruction:

- Increasing staff capacity through further coaching and training in Literacy eg, Targetted Teaching of Reading, Vocabulary, Chatterboxes and Speech Sound Pics .
- Promote coaching and mentoring through the inclusion of a Pedagogical Coach
- Providing additional teacher aide time to support differentiated instruction across P-6 during Literacy Blocks in Targetted Teaching of Reading
- Develop a shared understanding of 'data literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching.


