Provide resources to work towards our school targets of :

- 75% of students achieving C or above in English
- 75% of students achieving at year level or above Cluster on the Literacy Continuum
- LOA data in English reflects reading results.
- All students reading at National Minimum standards in years 3 and 5 NAPLAN Reading.

Our initiatives include

- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching text processing and comprehension across learning areas or subjects
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards including Early Start, Literacy Continuum and Intervention
- Promote coaching and mentoring through the inclusion of a Mentor Teacher
- Develop a network of local early childhood centres and kindergartens to enhance knowledge of on-entry to Prep expectations and to assist in a smooth transition of children into Prep and Year 1 through a co-investment model with local schools of an Early Years Coach

| • Providing additional Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy for intervention | \$80,000 |
| • Providing additional teacher aide support for Intervention | \$60,000 |
| • Provide additional professional development for identified areas | \$59,000 |
| • Allocate TRS to support initiatives (release for data analysis, moderation PD etc) | \$ 30,000 |
| • Increase resources for reading comprehension | \$ 30,527 |
