Provide resources to work towards our school targets of :

- All students reading and writing at National Minimum standards in years 3 and 5 NAPLAN

## Our initiatives include

- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching text processing and comprehension across learning areas or subjects
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for explicit teaching of writing
- Increase teachers' repertoire of engagement strategies in class and in social situations
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards including Early Start, Literacy Continuum and Intervention
- Promote coaching and mentoring through the inclusion of a Mentor Teacher
- Promote engagement for all students in a tiered approach through academic and wellbeing

Engagement:

• Increasing staff capacity through coaching and training - Mentor Teacher	\$ 120,000
• Providing additional Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy for intervention	\$80,000
• Providing additional teacher aide support for Intervention	\$60,000
• Providing additional teacher aide support for engagement and self regulation	\$50 000
• Provide additional professional development for identified areas	\$60,000
• Allocate TRS to support initiatives (release for data analysis, coaching etc)	\$ 40,000
• Increase resources for engagement (academic and wellbeing)	\$ 26 385
